About the Institution:

The Gauhati University Institute of Distance and Open Learning, formerly known as Post Graduate Correspondence School was established in May 1998. The main objective of this institute is to provide an opportunity to pursue higher education to the large number of learners who are unable to enroll into conventional mode of higher education due to various constraints like limited number of seats in Post Graduate classes, livelihood compulsions etc. The institute has completed two decades of its existence and aims to continue the mission of imparting quality education in an intellectually challenging learning environment. Apart from the Self-Learning Materials and Counseling Services, GUIDOL also imparts education through Radio Luit, the Community Radio Center.
