This is for the information to all the learners of Institute of Distance and Open Learning, Gauhati University that the MCQ based Internal Assessment Test for MA/MSc/MCom in the subjects viz. **Assamese, English, Economics, History, Political Science, Commerce, Mathematics, Bengali and Education** in both 2nd & 4th Semester will be held from the last week of May, 2016. The assessment will be based on objective type questions having four multiple responses. The test will carry 80 **Multiple Choice Questions** covering the syllabus as given. All learners will be allowed to appear in the test for only 1 (one) attempt. Each question will carry 1 (one) mark only. The schedule for the said examinations will be notified on 19/04/2016.
